ELECTRONIC DEVICES POLICY

The school makes available to the students electronic or computerized technology (lap tops, iPods, internet, promethean boards etc.) This technology is intended to facilitate and support the educational objectives of the school. The students must always get permission from their teacher prior to using any electronic or computerized technology. The school prohibits the transmission of any materials protected by trade secret, which violate local, state, and federal law or regulation, as well as the use of internet for other purpose different from the educational.

Students are allowed to bring their electronic devices to school for educational purpose **ONLY**, under the Christian ethic code of FFS, and under teachers' supervision. The school has the right to collect and examine any device at any time to be sure that school policies, regulations, or guidelines on use of the device have not been violated. Inappropriate content on a personal device will not be tolerated.

The students bring their electronic devices to school at their own risk. The school will not be held responsible if an electronic device is lost, stolen or damaged. The students are required to keep their devices off and in their book bag. The students are expected to report to faculty or administration any suspected misuses of any personal devices, or authorized applications.

In the event that the student has his/her electronic device confiscated at FFS by any staff member the following consequences will be administered:

Consequences of Electronic Policy Violation

Any violation of the regulations and policies in the agreement is unethical and may result in revocation of privileges, school disciplinary action (up to expulsion), and/or appropriate legal action.

- The first infraction: the device will be taken away and parents must pick it up at the office.
- The second infraction: the device will be taken away, students will have detention and parents must pick it up at the office.
- The third infraction: the device will remain in office until parent or guardian comes and signs for the device: device will be banned for the rest of school year.
